

## Deconstructed landscapes

Try a new way to explore a landscape by creating a composite of multiple fragments of it that you've taken during a short walk. A half hour stroll is all you need. Shoot anything that catches your eye. You need to take at least 25 photos each. When you're back in the lab, create a grid in Photoshop and assemble your selection of picture using Layers.

This example uses a 3x4 grid.



For your assignment, you will take 20 photos and assemble them together in a 5x4 or 4x5 grid. Create a new PS file and make it A4 size at 200 DPI.

Put your photos into the grid in a way that is pleasing to the eye. Don't just jumble them all together. Think of colours and shapes that go together.
